Hoop Star's Tournament Rules 2008

Hoop Star's Basketball Tournament Rules

1A. each team will provide one Adult Volunteer to operate the clock and keep Official Hoop Star's Score Book. A fee of \$10.00 will be paid by the teams head coach if they are not able to supply a adult volunteer.

" 2 adult volunteers are required 1 from each team "

1B. Eligibility is based on either the player's grade he or she is currently enrolled in, or the age of the player at the time of the tournament. Coaches may be asked to provide proof of grade or age at the tournament director's request. Some players can be older if pre-approved by the tournament director.

(Example: In order to play in the 5th grade or 11& under division, a player must be in the 5th grade or be a 6th grader but 11 years old)

2.No player will be allowed to play with more than one team in the same grade division.

3. All girls divisions will use a 28.5 ball. Boys divisions 3rd - 6th and Boys division consisting of 6th & 7th grade will play with a 28.5 inch ball. Boys divisions 7th and older will use a 29.5 ball.

4. Medals will be determined by the following guidelines, and in this order for round-robin divisions:

- Win-Loss record
- Head to Head
- Point Differential (maximum of 15 points per game)
- Total points allowed

*The same criteria will also be used to determine seeding following pool play in divisions that have pool play and then a tournament.

5. All games will consist of two 18 minute halves except for pool play games it will consist of two 14 minute halves with the clock running except for the last two minutes of each half. In the last two minutes of each half, the clock will stop on all dead balls.
6. Half time will be four minutes unless we are running behind schedule. Two minute overtime. FOUR time-outs allowed per team/coach per game. One time-out will be awarded to each team per overtime period.
7. The clock will not stop once a team has a 20 point lead.
8. Warm-up time before a game will vary depending on the scheduled start time of each game. Every effort will be made to stay on schedule. Therefore if a game runs long, the warm-up time will be minimal for the next game, but will not be less than 2 minutes.
9. All coaches must complete their "Roster" and "Release of Liability" forms prior to starting play in their first game. If a tournament official has not requested this from you prior to tip-off, each coach is responsible for turning the form in at the scorer's table before tip-off. Failure to do so could result in forfeiture of any game played prior to these forms being turned in.

Only one coach from each team is to stand and coach their team from the bench all other coaches must remain seated.

If A Coach is given a warning for Unsportsmanship behavior the next warning will be a technical the second technical the Coach will be instructed to leave the Facility/Campus immediately!!
